Rep. Sean Patrick Maloney's Hurricane Preparedness Guide

July 2013

June 1st marked the beginning of another active hurricane season, scheduled to last through the month of November. The past few years we have seen the disastrous effects of natural disasters like Hurricane Irene, Tropical Storm Lee, and Superstorm Sandy. As hurricane season begins, it is important that we prepare for future disasters, so we can mitigate the property damage and other potential losses.

Taking early precautions, as well as having a recovery plan, is of paramount importance to minimize damage during hurricane season. I have put together a list of emergency contacts, important resources, and an emergency checklist to help you and your family stay prepared during this hurricane season.

In the aftermath, I want to continue to be your partner to ensure our communities rebuild stronger and are more resilient to future disasters. One of my first votes in Congress was strongly supporting the long-overdue passage of Sandy disaster aid. The safety and livelihood of Hudson Valley businesses and families should not be a partisan issue. As soon as the President signed this bill into law, I quickly got to work fighting to make sure government worked for the folks at home, by making sure businesses or individuals impacted by these disasters continue to receive the assistance they need.

Be Prepared

- ◆ **Create an emergency supply kit.**
- ◆ **Create and discuss an evacuation plan with your family. Include routes to local shelters, and plans for pets and family members with special medical needs.**
- ◆ **Fill up your car's gas tank.**
- ◆ **Review any insurance policies.**

During a Hurricane

- ◆ **Listen to the radio for critical information from the National Weather Service, or sign up for NY-ALERT.**
- ◆ **Check emergency supply kit.**
- ◆ **Bring inside anything that could be picked up by the wind.**
- ◆ **Close all windows and doors. Close and board up all windows and doors with plywood, if you do not have hurricane shutters.**
- ◆ **Turn your refrigerator and freezer to the coldest setting and keep closed as much as possible, in case of power outages.**
- ◆ **Turn off propane tank.**
- ◆ **Unplug small appliances.**
- ◆ **Listen to and follow evacuation orders, or any other emergency notifications.**

Emergency Checklist

- Water, one gallon of water per person per day, for drinking and sanitation**
- Food, at least a three-day supply of non-perishable food**
- Battery-powered radio and a NOAA Weather Radio with tone alert, and extra batteries for both**
- Flashlight and extra batteries**
- First Aid kit**
- Whistle to signal for help**
- Moist towelettes, garbage bags and plastic ties for personal sanitation**
- Wrench or pliers to turn off utilities**
- Can opener for food**
- Warm bedding and clothing, if temperature requires**
- Rain gear**
- Cash, travelers checks, or change**
- Paper towels**
- Fire extinguisher**
- Matches**
- Disinfectant, bleach and mosquito repellent**
- Cell phone with chargers, inverter or solar charger**
- Important documents**
- Insurance policies**
- Personal identification**
- Bank account records**
